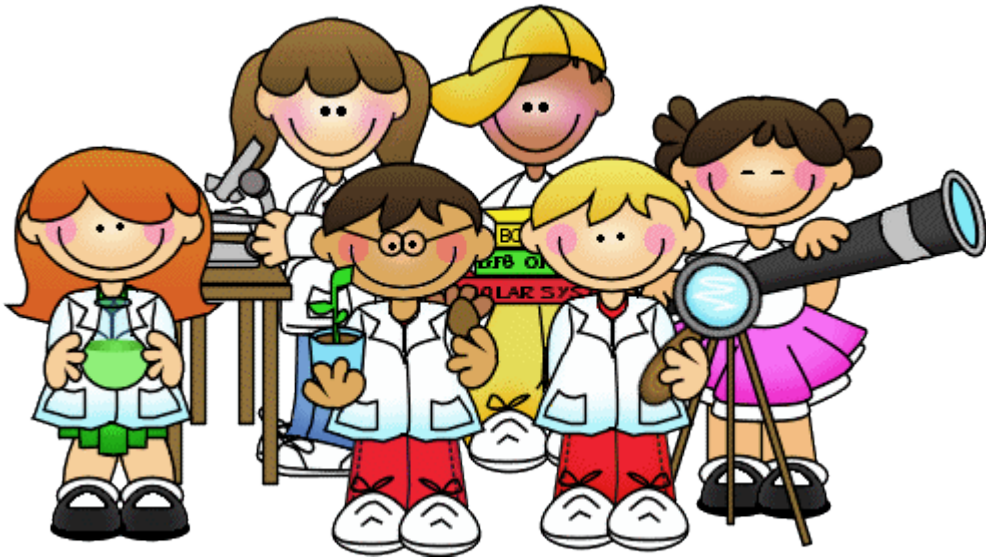

Campers' Choice

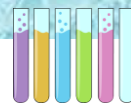

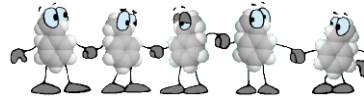
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Visitor: Mad Science – Crazy Chemistry

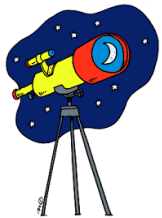
Trip: Hillsborough Cinema
