Overview

The goal of our Before Care and After Care Programs is to offer safe, fun, and educational opportunities to all students. In this program, we ensure students get on and off the correct buses, offer homework help, and allow time for kids to be kids with our carefully chosen games and sporting activities.

Busing

Both Hillsborough and Montgomery School Districts bus to and from our school. The districts do not transport to and from all schools within those towns. We also have our own busing company known as Gladstone Transportation that sometimes offer transportation where the districts do not. For more information, please contact the Director.

Homework Help

Homework Help is available for our After Care students. When they come off the bus, they go into our Homework Room. There, they can work on any homework assignments they may have.

Food & Nutrition

Families are welcome to supply their child with snacks and lunches or may take advantage of our school snacks and/or our catered hot lunch program.

- **Snacks:** Snack time is provided to after care students when they come off the bus. Our snack time is also when dinners can be heated for students whose families provide them. School snacks consist of cereal, fresh fruit, or applesauce. Water is always offered to accompany snack. Our snack service is included in your monthly tuition.

Active Area

Our All Purpose Room is set-up with things our older students like to do. Located in the All Purpose Room is our active area. This area is available to students who like to play active games such as, Gaga, Four Square, etc. Also available in this room are centers like, blocks, board games, art, Legos and much more.

Playground

Weather permitting, students will go outside to our large, child-friendly playground. Each part of our playground was specially designed with appropriate activities. Outdoor play provides students the opportunity to enhance their gross-motor skills, to build muscle and to improve coordination, and it provides an atmosphere for positive interactions with peers.
