Infant 2 Program (12 Months to 18 Months)

Overview

Our Infant 2 Program focuses on learning through play while building independence. In this class, students should start to walk independently, imitate simple words, and finger-feed themselves.

Curriculum Programs

Creative Curriculum

Creative Curriculum is a comprehensive, research-based curriculum designed to help teachers and caregivers implement developmentally appropriate practices. It offers responsive daily routines and meaningful experiences that nurture learning and development.

Personalized Care

We offer personalized care for each of our students to best suit their particular needs. This includes a daily Infant Care Schedule that is filled-out by a parent or guardian, updated as needed. The schedule is used to provide the teachers with instructions for care so the students can be happy and smiling all day long. Parents provide snacks and meals. Foods that need refrigeration can be stored in a refrigerator in the classroom. Besides store-bought formula, parents may also supply breast milk.

Sign Language

The goal of our Sign Language Program is to introduce another form of communication to all our students that will help them communicate without frustration. Sign Language helps our students develop social and language skills even when they are in the beginning stages of developing vocabulary. Three signs are introduced each week, but taught daily. Each of the program's nineteen signs are used every time a teacher says that word to reinforce the learning of the language.

Food and Facilities

Food & Nutrition

Families are welcome to supply their child with snacks and lunches or may take advantage of our school snacks and/or our catered hot lunch program. Note that our facility is completely nut-free, so no food of any kind containing nuts is allowed inside the school.

- **Snacks:** Snack time is provided three times a day at around 9am, 3pm, and 5pm. Our 5pm snack is also when dinners can be heated for students whose families provide them. School snacks consist of cereal, fresh fruit, or applesauce. Water is always offered to accompany snack. Our snack service is included in your monthly tuition.
- **Lunch:** Our hot lunches are catered by a local restaurant located in Montgomery Township. Each lunch is served in its own container and includes fruit, vegetable, and an entrée. Milk is also offered to all students who receive school lunch. Entrees include such items as, chicken tenders, grilled cheese, meatballs fish sticks, etc. A vegetarian option is always available. Our hot lunch program is optional. Please see the Director for prices.



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Facilities

Our Infant room is divided into two sections including a feeding area and a sleeping/activity area. The feeding area is equipped with highchairs for each student. There is also a mini fridge available in this classroom for anything that needs to be kept cold. There are also cubbies in this area where students can keep their personal belongings.

Our diapering area has all of each student's diapering belongings stored in individual bins that are labelled and kept organized. Our play area is closed off by a secure gate. Inside, there are soft mat obstacles for the students to play on as well as toys and books. Our cribs are also located in the play area. This does not affect napping students because in this class, students are sleeping at the same time.

Playground

Weather permitting, students will go outside to our large, child-friendly playground. Each part of our playground was specially designed with appropriate activities. Outdoor play provides students the opportunity to enhance their gross-motor skills, to build muscle and to improve coordination, and it provides an atmosphere for positive interactions with peers.
