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Kindergarten Enrollment FAQs

General Information

Q: Is morning or afternoon snack provided at ADLC?

A: Yes, snack is provided here at ADLC but parents are also welcome to provide snacks for their child

Q: What are the school hours of ADLC?

A: ADLC opens at 6:45 am and closes at 6:30 pm

Q: What will my child be learning at ADLC?

A: The curriculum is based on the state's standards. Students will learn math, science, social studies and literacy. For a more detailed explanation of the curriculum, please call us and set up a tour.

Q: What supplies will my child need at ADLC?

A: Students will need a pencil box, Expo markers, scissors, markers, pencils, crayons, and a glue stick when attending ADLC. For public school, teachers will normally send out a supply list in the summertime letting parents know what students will need.

Kindergarten Enrichment

Q: What is Kindergarten Enrichment?

A: Kindergarten Enrichment is a half-day kindergarten program at ADLC. There are both AM and PM sessions. In order to attend a program at ADLC, a student must first be enrolled in a public school kindergarten program. The student would be in an ADLC kindergarten enrichment program opposite of when he or she attends a public school kindergarten program (ex. Student goes to public school kindergarten in the AM session, then comes to ADLC for PM kindergarten enrichment.)

Q: Is there an age requirement for my child to attend kindergarten enrichment?

A: Yes. In order for a child to be accepted in public school kindergarten or kindergarten enrichment at ADLC, they must be 5 years old on or before October 1 of the year, they enter kindergarten.

District Information

Q: What is the process of enrolling my child in public school kindergarten?

A: See information below for Hillsborough and Montgomery programs.

Hillsborough

For Hillsborough, the district website provides a registration portal that parents would need to complete and provide basic information about their child before they go to school to register in person. The link to the portal can be found here:

Montgomery

For Montgomery, there are 3 phases that need to be completed:

Phase 1: Be prepared to upload the following documents. Please make sure the images are legible and include all pages for each document.

1. Official birth record or passport (child must be five years old on or before October 1, 2021)
2. Proof of residency in the township (two of the following is required):
 - Fully executed lease in the name of the parent/guardian, which must reflect the current year and must be signed by both parties (landlord and tenant).
 - Deed or current property tax bill in the name of the parent/guardian. A mortgage statement is not acceptable.
 - Fully executed contract of sale if in the process of purchasing a home (follow-up documentation required)
 - Utility bill: home telephone, gas, electric, water, sewer or cable (must be in the name of the parent/guardian and dated within 60 days of date of enrollment)
3. Immunization record (most recent record)

Phase 2: Download, complete, and scan the following required documents for upload:

- [Physical Exam Form](#) (Physical Exams performed from Sept.1, 2020 will be accepted. Submit by Sept. 1, 2021)
- [Physical Exam Required Signature Page Form](#) (If your child has not had a physical from Sept. 1, 2020 or later, you must complete this form and submit it.)
- [Caregiver Form](#) (alternate daycare transportation form, if needed) Complete this form ONLY if your child will be picked up or dropped off at another location in Montgomery other than your home.
- [Home Language Survey Form](#) (You will also answer similar questions when you do the online registration. They serve different purposes)

- [Kindergarten Student Information Form](#) (You will also answer similar questions when you do the online registration, since they serve different purposes.)
- [Authorization for Release of Information Form](#) (Please complete with the preschool's name and address that your child attended.) If your child did not attend a preschool program, please write "NONE" in the school's name and submit this document.

Paperwork Needed for School Registration

Q: What paperwork is needed for when I meet with the school for registration?

A: For Hillsborough, parents should bring their ID, their child's birth certificate, immunization forms, a physical form that is completed by a doctor (can be found on the school registration website), a deed or lease to Hillsborough residence and a current utility bill (no cell phone bill).

For Montgomery, parents must send in:

1. A birth certificate or passport of the child
2. Deed or current property tax bill in the name of the parent/ guardian
3. Fully executed contract of sale in the process of purchasing a home
4. Utility bill (that is within 60 days of enrollment)
5. Most recent immunization record
6. School Health services form
7. Physical exam form and signature form
8. Caregiver form
9. Home language survey form
10. Kindergarten student info form
11. Authorization for release of info form

Q: Will my child eat lunch at public school or at ADLC?

A: Students will always eat lunch at ADLC.

Q: Will bussing be provided from my child's school to ADLC?

A: Gladstone Transportation, ADLC's private bussing company can provide bussing to and from Amsterdam and Hillsborough Elementary School from Hillsborough and Orchard Hill in Montgomery. Woods Road provides bussing to All Day Learning Centers.

Q: How do I get a bus pass for my child?

A: You will need to call transportation and fill out a bus form in order to receive a bus pass. The bus form can be found on the transportation section of the website.

Full Day Kindergarten at ADLC

Q: Will my child have homework?

A: Yes, but only full day kindergarten students. Students will be given a homework packet every week that is to be completed by Fridays.

Q: If my child were to attend full day kindergarten, how many snacks times are there, what time is lunch and what time does the academic day start and end?

A: There are three snack times: one in the morning, one mid-afternoon, and one in the evening. Lunch is at 11:30 for full-day kindergarten. The school day begins at 8:45 am and ends at 3:00 pm.

Q: Is there an age requirement for my child to attend full-day kindergarten at ADLC?

A: In order for a child to attend full day kindergarten at ADLC, the student must be 5. However, in order for that student to be able to attend 1st grade the following year, they must meet the October 1 deadline.
